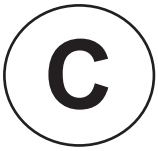


C FINGERING CHART



for use with *Hall Crystal Flutes and Piccolos in the key of C*

If you are playing the Hall Crystal Flute in C, this chart will play the exact notes shown below. If you are playing the Hall Crystal Piccolo in C the actual notes played will be one octave higher than shown below. As an option, you may prefer to use the D chart as a transposing chart. The D fingering chart is standard because it places the notes in the center of the music staff and makes the music easier to read. The keys of D and G are also common keys for Irish and folk music. If you are coming from a recorder background, this C chart may be a better choice for you.
