

# E<sub>b</sub> FINGERING CHART

for use with Hall Crystal Flutes in the key of E<sub>b</sub>,



If you are playing the Hall Crystal Flute in E<sub>b</sub>, this chart will play the exact notes shown below. As an option, you may prefer to use the D chart as a transposing chart. The D fingering chart is standard because it places the notes in the center of the music staff and makes the music easier to read. The keys of D and G are also common keys for Irish and folk music.
